New Point System

Fort Mill's Student Council has prided itself on having the best of the best, and with that superiority, our members are usually overachievers. In no way is this a bad thing, but it does make lives difficult. Some members are involved in 3 or more separate clubs/teams, all with their own meetings and practices. This can get very complicated in terms of keeping members accountable and engaged in activities.



In an effort to help this both our members and our advisors, we have developed a point system. **In this system, members are now required to earn 100 Meeting Points and 200 Service Points per year.**

- ◇ Attendance at meetings will earn you 5 points per meeting. You can find a list of all scheduled meetings at right. This allows you to prioritize your involvement in other activities.
- ◇ Service Points are explained at far right.
- ◇ In addition, Student Body positions will also have earned point requirements (TBD) in order to run in the following year.

Special Considerations:

- ◇ 50 Meeting Points must be accrued before Winter Break in order to be considered an active member.
- ◇ Dates in October might be changed to Committee Meetings (worth Service Points) due to Hunger Drive preparations.
- ◇ Dates in November, December, and January might be changed to Committee Meetings (worth Service Points) due to Pageant preparations.

Service Points

(Subject to change)
200 Points per year Required

Refer to the chart below for Service Point Values.

Major Event Examples : Day of Pageant assistance (all day service)	50 pts
Minor Event Examples : Hunger Drive Kick-Off, Freshman Orientation, Senior Celebration	25 pts
Assistance/Preparation Examples : Fall Fling Set Up, Spring Fling Take Down, SW Shirt Sales, Hunger Drive Bag delivery/pick-up	15 pts
Supply Provision Examples : SW Game Supplies, Poster Making, Poster hanging, T-shirt Design	10 pts
Committee Service Examples : Hunger Drive, Pageant	5 pts

Tiered Student Body Point Requirements:

To be eligible to run for a Student Body position next year, you must have earned the following Service Point during the school year:

- ◇ SB President= 350 pts
- ◇ SB Vice President= 300 pts
- ◇ SB Secretaries and Treasurer= 250 pts
